

**Name of activity: Pencil Obstacle Course**

**Purpose / Key words:** fine motor, visual motor, visual perceptual, executive functioning

**Age range:** K- grade 2, grade 3-5

**Materials:**

- **Printed worksheet (attached below)**
- **Pencil**

**Instructions:**

1. Follow instructions indicated on the obstacle course worksheet

**Activity Modification:**

- **To simplify**
  - Hand-over-hand assistance for more difficult lines, i.e. spirals
  - Adult can write the more difficult lines first, and the child can trace over them
- **To make more challenging**
  - Challenge the child to create and draw their own pencil obstacle course
    - Be as creative as possible!
