Name of activity: Cereal Box Puzzle









Purpose / Key words: fine motor, visual motor, visual perceptual, executive functioning

Age range: k- 2 grade grade 3-5,

Materials

- Cereal box
- Scissors
- Coin
- Writing utensil

Instructions

- 1. Cut the front of the cereal box off
- 2. Flip it over and use a pencil to draw 3 vertical lines and 5 horizontal lines evenly spaced to create puzzle pieces
- 3. Take a coin and trace half of it to create the interlocking edges of the puzzle pieces
- 4. As you create the interlocking edges on the puzzle pieces, make sure to erase the lines that are not needed.
- 5. Cut out the pieces using scissors.
- 6. Construct the puzzle.

Activity Modification

- To simplify
 - Pre-cut out the puzzle for your child
 - Choose a cereal box with a simple design
 - Make fewer puzzle pieces (3x3 / 3x4)
- To make more challenging
 - Make more puzzle pieces (5x5)

- Choose a cereal box with a more complex design
- Use multiple cereal boxes to create a complex puzzle
